Registration

Upon enrollment, an annual registration fee, supply fee, and insurance fee will be due within 7 days of receiving a written acceptance from Lifespan Montessori. *Please note that these fees are non-refundable.* Reenrollment occurs every January for the fall of that year. At that time, all enrollment fees are due.

Payments

Tuition payments will be due on the first day of the month and are paid one month in advance. After the 5th day of the month, late fees will be applied. For families with two enrolled siblings in full-time programs, a 15% discount will be applied to the eldest child's tuition.

Late Fees

At the first instance of a payment being more than 5 days past due, a late fee of \$35.00 will be added to their account. At the second instance of payment being more than 5 days past due, a late fee of \$55.00 will be added to their account. At the third instance of payment being more than 5 days past due, we reserve the right to remove the child from the program. Parents should see the Director or Administrator if specific arrangements are necessary for full payment. There are no allowances made for sick days, vacations, or leaves of absence. As long as the child's space is reserved in our program, full payment is required.

Applications for enrollment to Lifespan Montessori are accepted throughout the year and are dated upon receipt. Submitting an application for admission places your family on our waiting list. Though the administration strives to place children into age-appropriate classrooms as soon as possible and in alignment with parent preferences, placement may not occur within a family's desired timeframe. Families will remain on the waiting list until a space opens for their child and an invitation to enroll will be extended through phone and/or email. Once contacted, families are offered up to one week to make their decision. If the space is declined, families have the choice to remain on the waiting list or be removed.
